



VICTIMS' HAVE RIGHTS IT'S THE LAW!

AS VICTIMS OR SURVIVORS OF CRIME, YOU HAVE SPECIFIC RIGHTS AS OUTLINED IN S.960.001 OF THE FLORIDA STATUTES. YOUR RIGHTS ARE LISTED BELOW.

1. You have the right to be informed, present, and heard, when relevant, at all crucial stages of criminal proceeding, and to be told how to participate in a proceeding in a case of incarcerated victims, the right to be informed and submit written statements at all crucial stages of criminal and parole proceedings.
2. You have the right to seek financial compensation.
3. You have the right to crisis intervention support, and social services assistance within the community.
4. You have the right to be protected from intimidation.
5. You have the right to submit a victim impact statement to the court.
6. You have the right to seek restitution from the offender for financial losses/expenses.
7. You have the right to the return of your property unless a compelling reason exists to retain it.
