# PAROLE DENIED !!!

March 12, 2003, at the Florida Parole Commission hearing on Colin Russell, Maureen Bishop was the primary speaker. She is the daughter of Dan Crowder, a Fish and Game Commission Officer, who while trying to issue a ticket to Colin Russell for poaching, was repeatedly shot with Russell's high powered rifle just to avoid paying the fine.

Per Sheila Greenleaf (Training Specialist of the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office), Ms. Bishop reminisced about the night her father was killed; about growing up without her father, and having children of her own who would never know their grandfather. She put Colin Russell in the same category as someone killing a police officer over a speeding ticket.

Also present were representatives from the Florida Police Chiefs Association and the Florida Fresh Water Fish and Game Commission; Lee Martin, Host of the Justice Coalition's "Voice For Victims" Radio Show, Dick Braendle, Justice Coalition's Chief Courtwatcher, Mike

Wigley, Justice Coalition volunteer, Terry Morgan, Dan Crowder's brother-in-law, and Maureen's uncle.

At the conclusion, after hearing everyone speak opposing any changes to Russell's sentence or parole, the Parole Commission decided no changes were necessary and would wait another five years before reviewing Russell's case.
