beatings that do not result in permanent disability or permanent disfigurement." The court concluded that the extent of the student's injuries was nothing more than "significant bruises or welts" and that there was no corresponding mental injury sustained by the child. Accordingly, the spanking did not constitute felony child abuse as a matter of law. However, the court also declared that this particular type of corporal punishment may indeed constitute the misdemeanor crime of

contributing to the dependency of a child.

This case was decided on December 10, 2004 and the name of the case is King v. State. It can be found in legal publications at 29 Florida Law Weekly, D 2768.

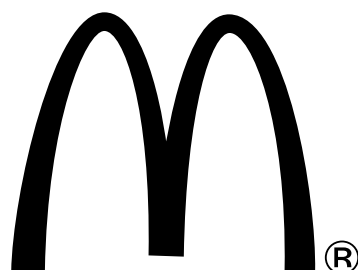
