National Center of Missing and Exploited Children. It allows citizens to report suspected possession of child pornography.

"The department has also created regional Internet Crimes Against Children Task Forces to assist state and local law enforcement in the effort to protect kids from sexual exploitation."

## What you can do

I recently received two different items of information I want to pass on to you. First is the Family Watchdog website which allows you to see on a map all registered sexual offenders/predators in your area. Go to [www.familywatchdog.us](http://www.familywatchdog.us), enter your address in the space provided and click on Get Map. A map will appear with color-coded squares indicating where an offender lives and/or works. (See graphic) Click on the square to view picture of offender. A legend to the left of the map explains the color

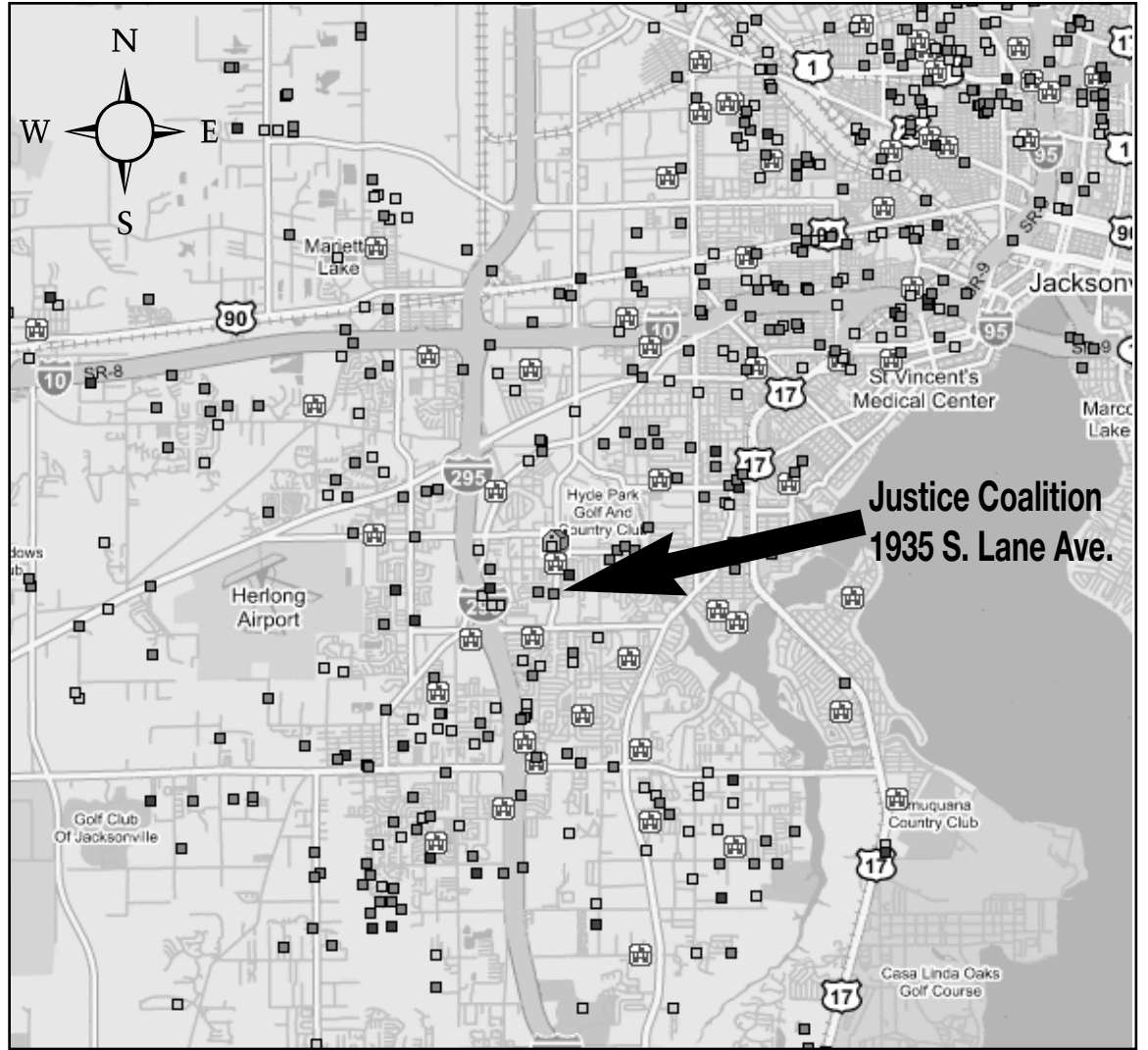
codes.

Next, retired FBI Agent Bill Kelly forwarded to me an item from the Florida Family Association (August 2005) with this information that I believe is good to know:

## HOW YOU CAN HELP

If you see a convenience store that sells one of the brands of gasoline listed below that is also selling pornographic magazines or videos, there is a good chance the store may be violating the terms of the marketing agreement with the major oil company. Sending an email to report the store to the major oil company may result in the removal of the pornographic magazines or videos.

Your email message should include the store name, address and type of pornography sold (magazines, videos, DVDs). If the store continues to sell the materials six weeks after you sent your email, please send the information on the store to [ffa@floridafamily.org](mailto:ffa@floridafamily.org).
