WANTED

Jacksonville Beach Police are seeking for questioning a man involved in a road rage incident December 10, 2005.

According to witnesses, Adam W. Loyche, 22, instigated an altercation with a white male, 5'10", with medium blonde hair, driving a mid-90's, dark blue Nissan standard cab pickup truck. Both drivers stopped their vehicles at Ninth Avenue and 13th Street North, got out and started arguing. The driver of the Nissan truck pushed Loyche, who fell to the ground, striking his head and cracking his skull. He died a week later of his injuries.
