waiting for an answer, [and this is] certainly not the answer we hoped for. But we now have closure and can finally put our darling Tina to rest... The doctor said that her remains have been out there since she disappeared in March 2000. All they could tell us is that her death is labeled a "homicide by violence." That is all we know, because they don't want to jeopardize the integrity of the investigation. Unless there is an arrest made and a trial is held, we may never know any more than that.

During their time of grief and uncertainty, Linda Rice and a few others started *Families of Missing Loved*

wrote a poignant article, *Surviving Through Grief*, published in the September 2003 edition of the *Victims' Advocate*, an excellent roadmap for others coping with violent death.

As in every other family who has suffered the violent loss of a loved one, the Rices continue to mourn for their daughter and struggle with the knowledge that a vicious murderer is walking free somewhere,

"The loss of a child has no ending, until we meet again in Heaven. We have so many questions, so many whys, and nothing seems to help the deep sorrow and pain we live with each day. For nearly four years, we pray that someone will come forward with answers that would bring justice for Tina. Until those responsible are found, we remain broken hearted. If anyone knows anything, please do the right thing and tell the authorities."
