...to May Martinez, grieving mother of Colleen Slemmer who was murdered 14 years ago in Knoxville, Tenn. Despite the pain of her loss and the

subsequent ordeal of seeing justice served, May has continuously reached out to help other victims of violent crime. Each Christmas she buys gifts, food and/or needed supplies for families suffering as she has done, because she understands how much it means to go through holidays without loved ones.

Colleen was attending the Job Corps in Knoxville when on January 13, 1995, she was brutally murdered by a group of Satan worshippers. Her death was so vicious part of her skull was broken off when the killers crammed stones inside her head. A pentagram was carved on her chest while she was still alive, and she was stabbed/cut more than 300 times.

Christa Pike, the ringleader

of this cruel, violent trio, was sentenced to death but continued to appeal her sentence. Because of the possibility of a re-trial, the Tennessee court has held Colleen's skull for evidence all these years.

With the help of Ann Dugger and the Justice Coalition, May has fought unceasingly to retrieve all the remains of her daughter's body so she can give her a proper burial. Just last month a judge finally ruled that Pike has exhausted her appeals, and the remaining body parts were released to May on the 22nd when she and Ann flew to Knoxville. Colleen's final remains were cremated and her

funeral was held on Jan. 23.

May says Ann has been with her from Day 1 and she appreciates so much all the Justice Coalition has done to help her. JC supporters have supplied funds for airfare, lodging during the trial in Tennessee, and even this last trip to bring back her daughter's remains. And, especially, she appreciates that Ann has provided moral support, compassion and whatever help she needed to get through the dark, difficult days.

Our hats are off to this valiant mother for her persistence in obtaining justice for her daughter, and for her generosity in reaching out to others.

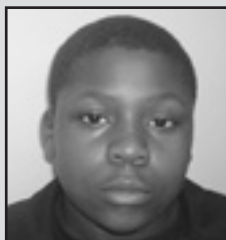

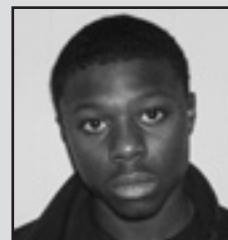

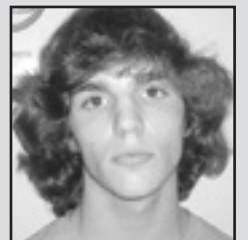
