State Representative Kravitz receives award



Representative Dick Kravitz (R) received a House Leadership Award from the Florida Prosecuting Attorneys Association at their annual meeting on Marco Island in July. As Chairman of the House Criminal Justice Committee, he has sponsored or co-sponsored many pro-prosecution and victims' rights bills during his two-year tenure. The two most notable are the Jessica Lunsford Act, which imposed a minimum mandatory 20 years to life sentence on individuals found guilty of molesting a child 12 years of age or younger, and HB147, which grants prosecution the closing argument to the jury in all criminal cases. Congratulations to Rep. Kravitz, a committed victim's advocate for more than 20 years, for receiving this honor.
