

F.O.P. President David Stevens has resigned



Fraternal Order of Police President David Stevens has resigned his position. Stevens, a lieutenant with the Sheriff's Office who recently received a letter encouraging him to apply for a job with Sheriff John Rutherford, said he resigned because, "it's the right thing to do for me and for the membership."

David Stevens has been employed by the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office

since 1978. He spent seven years as a patrol officer before moving to the Traffic/Special Operations Unit and then onto the Vice Squad where he worked for five years as a detective. He was promoted to Sergeant in 1993 and then to Lieutenant in 1998. David was installed as President of the Jacksonville Fraternal Order of Police in January 1998 for a 2-year term and was then re-elected.

Fraternal Order Of Police Installs New President

The Fraternal Order of Police swore in Nelson Cuba, who replaced outgoing president David Stevens. Cuba, who has been with the union for eight years, ran unopposed for the Vice Presidency in 1998.

"It was a dream of mine to go into law enforcement. My mother always told me that if you want to change something, you have to get involved and do it yourself. That's what I did, and years later, here I am. David is 100 percent supportive of me. If he didn't think I was ready he wouldn't have stepped down," said Cuba.

Nelson Cuba is already planning his year. He is ready to move forward and continue the fight. Nelson said, "it hasn't totally hit me that I am the new President, but I know I'm well prepared.
