

Save Terri Schiavo

On a blustery day in Jacksonville, the Justice Coalition held a press conference on the Federal courthouse steps to plead for the life of Terri Schiavo. Joined by her family, several politicians, religious figures

and many other supporters, Ted Hires, Sr., asked the Department of Children & Families to take Terri into protective custody and for Attorney General Charlie Crist to initiate a civil rights investigation into her treatment

and efforts by her husband to have her feeding tube removed.

Terri's parents, Bob and Mary Schindler, and brother, Bobby Schindler, who drove from Tampa last Monday to attend the press conference, offered evidence rebutting persistent media reports that she is in a "vegetative state." The family was overwhelmed by the outpouring of support from total strangers who are joining their 15-year fight to

save their daughter's life.

Rep. Don Davis, who joined Ted Hires' request for Gov. Bush to appoint a special prosecutor to investigate the cause of Terri's condition, questioned Michael Schiavo's actions since his wife's hospitalization. "I'm convinced that he wants her to die so she won't be...rehabilitated to the point where she can become cognizant again and tell us what really happened that

evening 15 years ago," he said.

Senator Daniel Webster submitted this statement: "By any definition Terri Schiavo is alive. Life is valuable, Terri's life is valuable, and her rights should be protected. As a state legislator I have and will continue to protect life, especially the lives of those who are most vulnerable."
