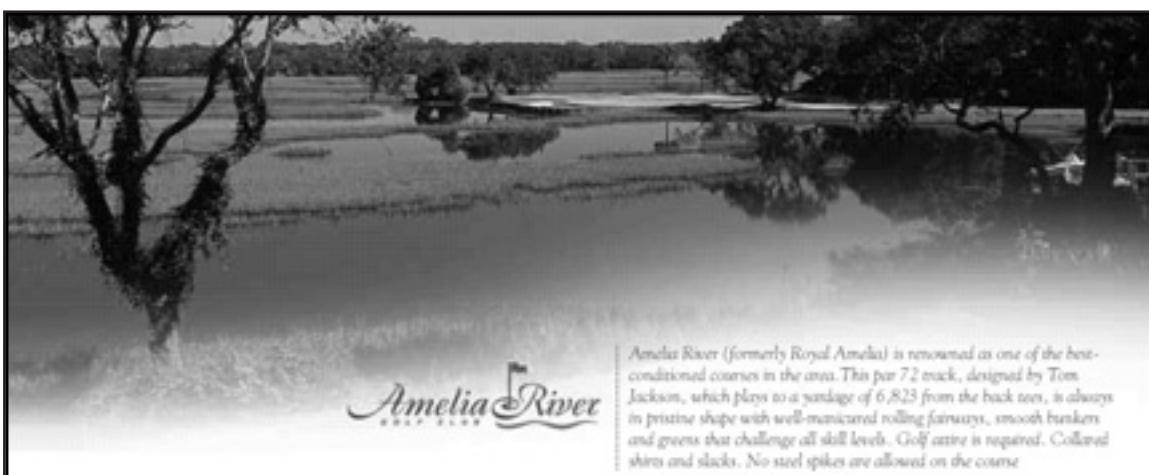

- Educate victims regarding their rights as a victim of crime and criminal justice proceedings.
